

2022 QUALIFYING FORMAT

The fastest two days on the NTT INDYCAR SERIES schedule are here - PPG Armed Forces Qualifying weekend. Over two days, drivers and teams will fight for one of the 33 positions in the starting field for the 106th Running of the Indianapolis 500 presented by Gainbridge.

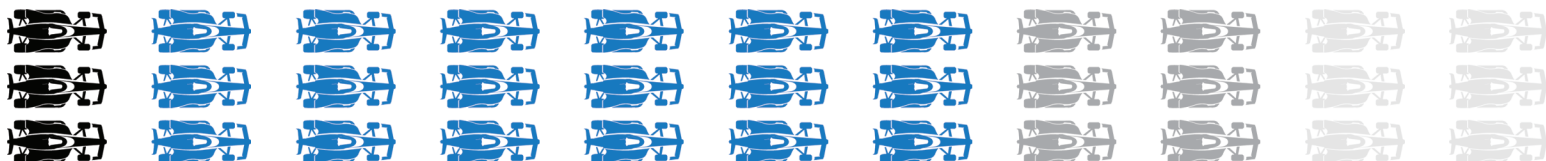

Positions 13-30 (or 13-33*) are set.

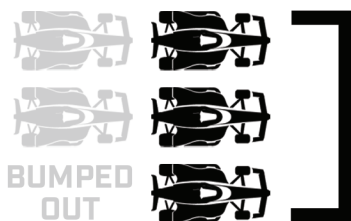
Will not requalify on Sunday.



NTT INDYCAR SERIES drivers and teams will attempt to qualify during Day One, Saturday, May 21. Top 12 qualifying (final order of positions 7-12), Firestone Fast Six (final order of positions 1-6) and, if necessary, Last Chance Qualifying (positions 31-33) will be determined during Day Two, Sunday, May 22. Once every car in the qualifying order for Saturday has been presented at least one chance to qualify, teams must choose from two lanes for second and subsequent attempts. Cars in the priority lane (Lane 1) must withdraw their qualified time – if the car has one – but get priority access to the track ahead of Lane 2. Lane 2 is for cars that have already qualified but wish to improve their position. For an entry list of more than 33, once cars are outside of the Top 30, they are considered to not have a qualification speed as only positions 1-30 will be locked in during Day One.

Each entry is guaranteed one attempt and can make multiple attempts until time expires. If multiple attempts are made, previous times are withdrawn and the fastest non-qualified car assumes the 33rd spot.

TOP 12 QUALIFYING 4-4:45 PM

POSITIONS 7-12 DETERMINED

Order based on Saturday times, slowest to fastest. Each entry is guaranteed one attempt. The fastest six advance to the Firestone Fast Six to determine positions 1-6.



FIRESTONE FAST SIX 5:10-5:40 PM

POSITIONS 1-6 DETERMINED

Order based on times from Top 12 qualifying, slowest to fastest. Each entry is guaranteed one attempt. The fastest driver in the Firestone Fast Six will earn the coveted NTT P1 Award for pole.
